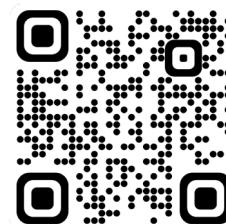
Travel and Stay Provisions

How to reach NERIE

NERIE, Umiam can be reached by road from Guwahati. It is around 85 Kms from Guwahati railway station. It is located adjacent to the North East Space Application Centre (NESAC), Umiam, Barapani, Meghalaya. From the National Highway No. 40 (GS Road) take the road opposite from Orchid Lake Resort and through the Barapani market. NERIE is at a distance of 2 kms from the main road.



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
