## GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

A team of 2 students will be invited / selected for participation both for oral and Poster presentation.

### Participation will be under two categories:

- Secondary level and
- Higher Secondary level.

All the papers / posters will be screened by an expert committee and acceptance will be notified. These presentations will be evaluated and judged for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize in the region among the 8 NE States. Each Group should be escorted to NERIE by a Guide teacher who has assisted the students in their work. TA for the team including the escort teacher will be borne by NERIE.

The paper / poster should be organised in the following format:

- Abstract with Key Words
- Introduction
- Objectives
- Method & Procedure
- Results & Discussion
- Conclusion and
- References

## HOW TO REACH NERIE

NERIE, Umiam can be reached easily by road from Guwahati. It is around 84 kms from Guwahati Railway Station. It is situated adjacent to the North East Space Application Centre (NESAC), Barapani, Meghalaya. From the National Highway No. 40 (GS Road), take the road opposite to Orchid Lake Resort and follow the road. It is at a distance of 2.2 kms from the main road.
